

St Thomas High School Teddy Bear Sweater

SKILL: Adv. Beginner

GAUGE

10cm X 10 cm

20 stitches

28 rows

Stockingette stitch

YARN

Medium weight (4)

Model - Patons Classic Wool Merino

1 skein Dark Grey Mix

1 skein Bright Red

1 skein Aran

NEEDLES

5mm/US 8 or size needed for gauge

NOTIONS

Stitch markers



BACK

Cast on 52 stitches. Work in k2, p2 rib for 6 rows, end on a WS row. **Beg St st: Row 1** (RS) knit increase 12 sts evenly across – 64 stitches across. Continue in pat until piece measures 3". Place stitch marker at beginning and end of row for base of armhole. Continue in pattern until arm hole measures 4" (piece measures 7"). Bind off first 20 stitches, place marker (neck opening). Bind next 24 stitches, place marker (neck opening). Bind last 20 stitches.

FRONT

Cast on 52 stitches. Work in k2, p2 rib for 6 rows, end on a WS row. **Beg St st: Row 1** (RS) knit increase 12 sts evenly across – 64 stitches across. Continue in pat through row 10. On Row 11 begin intarsia chart. At 3", place stitch marker at beginning and end of row for base of armhole. Continue until piece measures 6 ½ ", end with a WS row

Shape neck

Next row k25, join 2nd ball of yarn and bind off center 14 stitches, work to end. Working both sides at same time, bind off from each neck edge 1 stitch each row until 20 stitches remain. Bind off.

SLEEVES (Make 2)

Cast on 40 stitches. Work in k2, p2 for 6 rows, end on a WS row. **Beg St st: Row 1** (RS) knit evenly until piece measures 4".

FINISHING

Block pieces. Sew shoulders and sides together. Sew sleeves together. Set in sleeves

Neckband

With RS facing and circular needles begin at the right shoulder, pick up 24 stitches across the back neck, 4 along the left side, 14 across the front neck and 4 along the right side. Place marker, join and working in k2, p2 for $\frac{3}{4}$ ". Bind off in pattern.
